## Trial Class Information

At Brighton Dance Academy we are pleased to offer one obligation free trial per style, per year. Please see below some information to help ensure you have the best trial experience possible.

### Location

Please be aware we have three different studio locations at BDA. The location of each class is on our timetable and on your enrolment notification email. Classes can be held at:

- Bay St Studios – 104 Bay Street, Brighton
- St Andrews Church Hall – Corner St Andrews Street and Church Street, Brighton
- St Leonards Church Hall – 2 Wolseley Grove, Brighton

### What to Bring/Wear

We do not expect students to be in full uniform for their trial as we appreciate parents do not wish to invest in dance uniform until they know it is needed. Appropriate attire is listed below:

- Clothes you can move in such as leggings and a t-shirt – if you already own dancewear you are welcome to wear it for your trial regardless of colour.
- Hair up (if shoulder length or longer) or pinned back off face if too short to go up
- Bare feet/any dance shoes owned (or runners for Hip Hop)
- Water bottle

### Before Class

Please wait in outside and a teacher will come out at the start of class time to call the students in. *\*Parents cannot enter the building due to COVID-19 restrictions*

### After the Trial

Please contact the office after your class to confirm your enrolment.

After the trial class, students are expected to come to class in uniform and hair appropriately styled. Students doing ballet are expected to have a ballet bun with a bun net and pins. Uniform can be purchased from Capezio in Elsternwick. Please see our website for a uniform list if you are unsure.

### Concert Costume Fee

Costume fees are to purchase your child's concert costume and is broken up into 3 instalments to make each term's fees more affordable. The costume fee is per costume and your child will keep their concert costume after the performance. Classes or students not involved in the concert will not be charged a costume fee. Please email the office if you do not wish to participate in the concert so we can wave this fee. All three instalments of the costume fee must be paid by the start of term 3 as this is when we purchase costumes.

### Payment

Enrolment fees as well as prorated tuition and costume fees will automatically be issued upon registering for a class. These fees do not need to be paid until after your trial and you have confirmed your enrolment.
